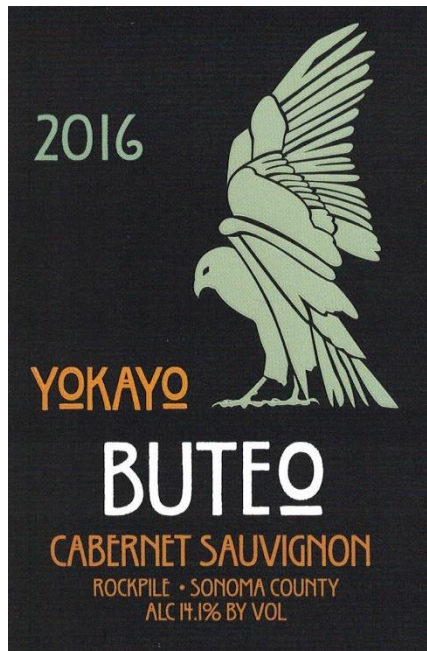

In 2006 the Pauli Family acquired a vineyard adjoining the Yokayo Ranch in the north west corner of the Ukiah Valley. In 2007 they built Yokayo Wine Company Winery and established the Yokayo brand.

With the inception of the Yokayo brand, the Pauli Family have been producing premium wines from their vineyards.

- **Blend:** 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Malbec, 9% Petite Verdot
- **Winemaker:** David Rosenthal
- **Appellation:** Rockpile, Sonoma County
- **Harvest Date:** Oct 8th, 2016
- **Harvest Analysis:** 26.6 Brix, TA: .58, PH: 3.69
- **Barrel Aging:** 100% barrel aged, 40% New French Oak, 30% 1 year French Oak, 30% 2 year French Oak
- **Winemaking Process:** 2 day cold soak for aqueous fruit extraction, aeration and cap management with pulsair device. After a 12 day ferment drained and pressed to a settling tank. Another 2 week settle and then racked into barrels to be aged for 20 months.
- **Alcohol:** 14.1%
- **Retail Price:** \$42.00

Winemaker Notes

This wine is crafted from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Petite Verdot grapes grown on steep hillsides with northern exposure in the Rockpile region of Sonoma County. At 1100 ft elevation this region looks down upon serene Lake Sonoma. On the nose, beautiful aromas of black cherry and currants burst from the glass. Flavors of blackberry and mocha with rich tannins invigorate your palate followed with a vanilla and spice finish.

Pair with barbecued ribeye, pasta amatriciana or paella.
