



Winemaker Notes

This wine is crafted from 100% Chardonnay grown in Yolo Gravely Loam on the valley floor at 950 ft elevation in Potter Valley, Mendocino County. The nose exhibits toasty oak with vanilla custard. On the palate this wine features apples, apricots, dried pear and a spicy oak butterscotch finish.

Pairs well with fresh Dungeness crab, broiled halibut or roasted chicken.
