



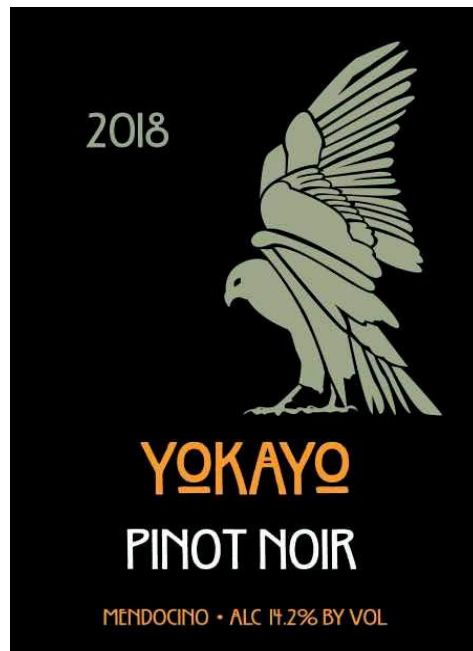

Winemaker Notes

This wine is crafted from 100% Pinot Noir grapes grown on hillsides in the Northwest portion of Potter Valley, Mendocino County. The winemaking process of a 5 day "cold soak" for aqueous fruit extraction followed by fermentation at 85°F and barrel aging brought out beautiful aromas of red berry, strawberry and vanilla in this wine. On the palate this wine features bright cherry with a spicy, toasty oak finish.

Pairs fabulously with smoked salmon, barbecued duck or tri-tip.
